## **Linda Mager - Superior Performance**

Linda came to Cincinnati from Detroit where she was on the Detroit City Team twice. She also finished either first or second in many certified tournaments in Phoenix, Arizona, Louisville, Kentucky as well as Hamilton and Cincinnati. Linda was on the Team that won the Cincinnati City Tournament 5 times and placed second once. In 2009 she and her partner placed first in the City doubles. Also in 2009 Linda and Theresa Bailey contributed to a 5-Lady state record score of 3444. Linda's career high game was 289, high 3 games 782, career high average 207. She has had 32 games of 279 or higher and 75 plus 700 games.

## **Pat Canfield - Meritorious Service**

Pat has been a member of the GrCUSBCWBA for over 20 years. She was secretary/treasurer of the Phil Share 2-lady league for over 17. Pat served on the Board of Directors for 11 years, serving on many committees during that time. Perhaps because Pat is a veteran, the Committee closest to her heart was the Bowlers to Veterans Link (BVL). She was the Tournament Director for the BVL Tournament for 10 years and served on the Committee for 7 years, chairing for 6 years. In 2001 while serving as the Chair, our Association had the largest increase in donations nationwide and Pat received a trip to Washington, D.C. to place a wreath at the tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

## **Theresa Bailey - Superior Performance**

Theresa served on the Board of Directors for a few years, but had to drop off because of the pressure of her job and increased travel. She is one of the leading bowlers in the area with a career high average for the past ten years of 213, and with a composite average (bowling in several different houses) over the past ten years of 203. Theresa has had 3 – 300 games, 1 – 299 and 2 - 800's. She was a member of 1st place GCWBA city team with Linda Mager who set a Ohio state record with their 5-Lady scratch score of 3444. Theresa was 1st in All Events 2008 & 2009 and in Doubles she was 1st in 2008 & 2nd 2009 with partner Amy Salter. Theresa currently hold the city high series with 825. In addition to being a great bowler, she is also a personable and truly nice lady.
