



Gloria Harper has been a member of the Greater Cincinnati and Ohio USBC WBA for forty years. Her high average of 205 was achieved during the 2005-2006 season. Her highest series is a 748 and she rolled a 296 game in 2002.

Gloria, along with partner Stacy Anderson, won the Actual and Handicap Doubles in the Ohio Women's Bowling Association Championship Tournament in both 2003 and 2004. These are the only back to back actual and handicap doubles champions in the history of the Ohio USBC WBA and their 1510 actual doubles score in 2004 set a tournament record at that time. In the Greater Cincinnati WBA City Tournaments, she was a member of the team that won the team handicap in 1982 and 1984 and team actual in 1987, 1990 and 2001.

Gloria was a member of the first place city Champ of Champs Team in 1986, a member of the Ohio Champ of Champs in 1986, won the Hoinke Classic Singles in 1986, and member of the team which won the Hoinke Classic Team event in 1987. She was a member of the team that won the Evansville Ten Pin Classic, Louisville Fillies Team Actual in 1996 and both actual and handicap Hoinke Classic Team in 2002.

She has rolled twenty games of 279 to 296 and eighteen 700 series.

During the past bowling season she bowled in three leagues with her highest average being a 190. Gloria was inducted into the Greater Cincinnati USBC WBA Hall of Fame in 2007.

It is with extreme pleasure that we add the name of Gloria Harper to those already enshrined in the STAR OF YESTERYEAR category in the Ohio USBC Women's Bowling Association Hall of Fame.
